If you are uninsured and/or have difficulty affording your medications:

The Lincoln Heights Pharmacy participates in the 340B drug-pricing program. Drug manufacturers are required to provide outpatient medications at a reduced price to Community Health Centers like ours. The savings are passed on to our uninsured/underinsured patients to provide affordable medications.

As a HealthCare Connection patient, you are already enrolled in this prescription drug assistance program, allowing you to save up to 90% on eligible prescriptions written by your HealthCare Connection medical provider.

If you are Insured:

Our goal is that you will use our full-service pharmacy for your medications. The Pharmacy and Medical providers are dedicated to work as a team to fully manage your health. As your medical home, we prioritize your health care needs and we place emphasis on providing thorough patient counseling and education about your medications and health conditions.
