The HealthCare Connection (THCC) is a nonprofit, federally qualified health center (FQHC) based in Cincinnati, Ohio. It provides comprehensive primary care and support services to medically underserved individuals and families regardless of their ability to pay, aiming to reduce health disparities in the Greater Cincinnati region.

HISTORY AND MISSION

THCC originated as the Lincoln Heights Health Center, one of the first community health centers in Ohio. Founded during the national War on Poverty era, it was established to bring quality healthcare to marginalized and low-income neighborhoods. The organization's mission centers on ensuring accessible, quality, culturally competent care for all.

COMMUNITY IMPACT

As one of the region's largest community-based providers, The HealthCare Connection plays a crucial role in advancing health equity. It serves thousands of patients annually, many of whom live below the federal poverty line. Beyond direct healthcare services, it contributes to public health education, workforce development, and regional health planning, reinforcing its long-standing commitment to community well-being.

SERVICES AND PROGRAMS

THCC operates multiple health centers and school-based clinics across Hamilton County. Its offerings include family medicine, pediatrics, obstetrics and gynecology, dentistry, behavioral health, vision, HIV services, on-site Pharmacy, and care coordination. Sliding-scale fees and assistance programs support uninsured and underinsured patients. The organization also partners with local hospitals and public health agencies to expand preventive care initiatives and chronic disease management.
